Spring arrives this month! To get us in the mood, we will be learning about farm animals, jungle animals, St. Patrick's Day and how to care for pets. Along with learning.


Due to a lack of space, <u>PLEASE do not bring toys or backpacks to school</u>. We appreciate your help with this matter!


